EXHIBITION.

The exhibition is free but you are invited to reserve tables by sending the form enclosed before 10 June 2010 at the latest.

COMPETITION

It is open to all modellers (except AMC members), via the form enclosed that must be sent before 10 June 2010 at the latest. A 2 € fee per model will be asked at the registration desk. Models can be entered before 12 o'clock on Sat 26 June 2010, at a cost of 4 € per entry, provided there is enough room available. The models must be placed on competition tables between 8.30 am and 12.00 am.

The jury will be made of AMC members, who are not allowed to take a part in the competition.

COMPETITION RULES

The competition is open to any modeller, except AMC members. The number of models entered in every category is not limited, but only one model per modeller will be rewarded in each category.

Competition fee will be 2€ if entered before 10 June 2010, on the appropriate form;
4 € if the model is entered before 12am on Sat 26 June 2010 .

The model will be automatically disqualified if there is any sign or marking that enables the modeller to be identified. Pictures, sketches or drawings can be displayed with the model to illustrate it being built.

THE JURY :

Will be made of AMC members.
Its decisions cannot be questioned.

THE AWARDS:

The three best-ranked competitors in each category will get a prize.

Special awards : the “Best of Show” will be selected amongst the models displayed (exhibition + competition) the “Best Club Stand”

Other Awards can be added if necessary.

THE CATEGORIES :

The modeller can choose the category in which he/she wants to enter his/her model. The organizing committee, however, is entitled to enter the model in another category before the Jury meets.

A model cannot be entered in a “Diorama” category if it is displayed on a base covered with felt, a mirror or representing a road or a landing strip, for example.

The “Scratch” categories are reserved to models that are not available on the market. However, some parts like wheels, tracks, headlights, etc can be used from boxes. A detailed notice will describe the techniques and tricks used in building this scratch model.

If there is not enough models in a category, the Jury is entitled to regroup two or several categories together.
